What we do

- Vocational assessment on-site with injured worker
- Transitional return-to-work development
- Vocational testing to determine transferable skills
- Labor Markey Survey (as requested)
- Communicate and coordinate with attorney (as requested/required)
- Effective resume preparation tailored to specific job leads
- Application and interviewing skills training
- Vocational counseling and positive reinforcement
- Facilitate job leads, injured worker placement activities
- Follow up and maintain complete and accurate documentation
- Obtain job analysis for treating MD approval
- Expert Testimony (as needed)
